Following points were discussed during the teleconference:

(i) Feedback on Coaching Classes in Ghatsila Area:

Feasibility study and Project Report on Coaching Classes in Ghatsila area is to be prepared by Mr Mangal Mandi in consultation with members of Jamshedpur Chapter. Report to be submitted by mid April 2018 for further go ahead.

(ii) Setting up of Cold Storage / Horticulture project in Mayurbhanj district of Odisha:

Mr Dayanidhi Marandi shared the detail development on the project. Jashipur in Mayurbhanj district of Odisha has been identified as the location for the said project. Project will be under support of National Horticulture Board (NHB) and financed by NABARD. Project will be under Cooperative Society Model. 80% to 85% of project cost is subsidised. Seeding fund is being sponsored by Mr Rajmal Majhi. Technical expert Team along with SEA members are visiting the location on Sunday (1st April 2018) for further necessary action.

(iii) Progress Review on ICC Collaborated projects by Kolkata Chapter:

Mr Dasarathi Saren briefed about progress on ICC collaborated project. He informed that, project is initially planned to organise in three different locations in West Bengal. Till now Pandua and Jhargram are confirmed locations. Third location is being explored for the said project. On confirming these locations, Kolkata chapter to submit a project proposal to ICC by mid April 2018. Simultaneously, Kolkata Chapter to identify the participants and arrange all detail requirements for smooth conduct of the programmes.

Mr Somnath Hansdah informed that filling of ITR for last two years has been completed and receipt & acknowledgement is expected by end Mar 2018 from the agent. Further, Bhubaneswar Chapter to coordinate for the registration of SEA under 80G & FCRA.
